NUMOV is organizing an information seminar on Tunisia in the framework of the Energy Efficiency Export Initiative on behalf of the German Federal Ministry of Economics and Technology.

The increased standard of living has led to a marked rise in the consumption of electricity in private households. Between 2000 and 2005, consumption of electricity surged 30% in Tunisia. The good economic climate of the country continues to provide excellent conditions for foreign companies. Tunisia has already been able to significantly reduce the nation-wide consumption of electricity by means of the targeted promotion of electricity-saving measures, energy audits in the industry and the dissemination of energy-efficient household appliances. By 2011, the government thus targets to save 2,300 GWh per year. Economic relations between Germany and Tunisia have traditionally been very good and the country also offers a well-developed energy infrastructure in which nearly all households are connected to the national power grid.

The conference aims to improve the position of German companies. Medium-sized businesses are to be informed on the potential of the Tunisian economy; participating business representatives are to gain insights into the opportunities and potential fields of activity. The one-day event will comprise presentations by expert speakers from Germany and Tunisia.

The conference will be in English and is free of charge.
